COMBAT CLIMATE CHANGE

Trees absorb excess and harmful carbon dioxide from the atmosphere. In a single year, it takes about 96 trees to absorb the carbon dioxide produced by just one person.



INCREASE BIODIVERSITY

70% of all plant and animal species in the world live in forests. Deforestation threatens these habitats, and could result in the extinction of 28,000 species in the next 25 years.



PROVIDE CLEAN AIR

One mature tree releases enough oxygen to support two human beings. Trees also absorb pollutant gases such as nitrogen oxides, ammonia, sulfur dioxide, and ozone.
